Purpose: Understand words that will help you be a brave online explorer.

Can you find the **nine hidden words** on the map? Look up, down, across, backward and diagonally to find the words that remind you of how to be brave online!



Search for these words that will help you talk it out when you're in doubt:

AGENCY: The power to act or make a change, including protecting or standing up for yourself and others.

TRUST: Strong belief that someone or something is reliable or truthful.

BULLYING: Mean behavior that's repeated and meant to hurt someone. Cyberbullying is the digital form of this.

AGGRESSOR: A person harassing or bullying someone.

TARGET: The person being bullied.

BYSTANDER: A witness to harassment or bullying who recognizes the situation but chooses not to do anything about it.

COURAGEOUS: Brave; the ability to do something difficult even when there's risk.

MEDIA: A tool for communicating something (an idea, message, information, etc.). For example, TV, books and the internet are all forms of media.

VOICE: Taking a brave step by sharing your thoughts, feelings and opinions—something that matters to you—with the people around you.
